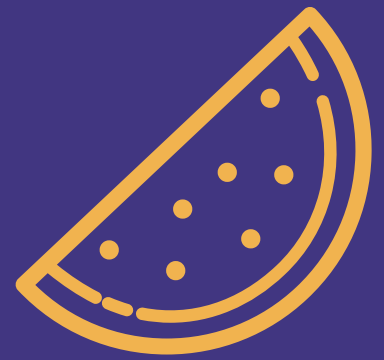

Invest in your community

To open our community-owned grocery store, Silverton Food Co-op will raise up to \$800,000 in interest-bearing loans from its member-owners. These member loans will account for over half of the \$1.5 million in capital we'll need to acquire before we open our store. This commitment of our owners will help secure the additional bank financing and grant money we will need.

Our member loan campaign is a unique opportunity to invest in a community enterprise whose values align with yours. Area residents established Silverton Food Co-op to bring local, farm-fresh food to a conveniently located grocery store. We are democratically owned and managed and our member-owners have a real say in what our store will be like to shop at, how it will be run, and what it will sell.

Our Food Co-op won't open and stay open, however, without the significant, long-term financial investment of our member-owners. This \$800,000 campaign will enable us to hire a general manager, build out an anticipated 4,000 sq. ft. facility, acquire equipment and fixtures for a commercial kitchen and retail grocery store, and position us to acquire additional bank financing.

We are seeking loans of \$2,000 and up from Co-op member-owners who have already purchased a full share of common stock.
